-  Aditya Birla Idea Payments Bank began its operations. It became the fourth Payment Bank to start its operations after Bharti Airtel, Paytm and FINO Payments Bank.
-  India successfully test-fired the nuclear-capable 'Dhanush' ballistic missile from a naval ship off Odisha coast. It has a strike range of 350 kms.
-  India successfully conducted a night trial of its indigenously developed nuclear capable Prithvi-II missile with a strike range of 350 km, from a test range in Odisha.
-  According to the latest report by non-government organisation Transparency International, India has been placed 81st in the Global Corruption Perception Index 2017. New Zealand has topped this list of 180 countries.
-  Flying officer Avani Chaturvedi has become the first Indian woman to fly a fighter aircraft.
